Page 3, top of page:

FRANCOIS

Let us tell another! The night is long, and stories will help
keep the shadows and our hunger away.

Change to:

FRANCOIS

Tell another!

Page 5, 1/3 down page

COPPENOLE

I tell you all ...

... through ...

JEHAN

Yet the whole of Paris ...

Change to:

COPPENOLE

I tell you all, the end of the world has come!

GRINGOIRE

The 6th of January, 1482 is not a day which most histories
recall.

COPPENOLE

These accursed inventions ... artilleries, bombards, printing!

JEHAN

Yet the whole of Paris was in commotion. It was Epiphany and
the Carnival of Fools.

COPPENOLE

It will kill the book as we know it.

Page 13, halfway down

FROLLO

... Such a twisted body, yet born with a firey strength hidden within. Left on the doorsteps ...

change to:

FROLLO

... Such a twisted body, left on the doorsteps ...

Page 16, end of scene

GRINGOIRE

Just as before, the square in a riot ... The Carnival is in chaos!

Change to:

GRINGOIRE

The same square, almost deserted now some hours later, the play hopelessly abandoned, the Carnival has moved on without them.

Page 71, 1/3 down

JEHAN

... made to suffer as she would make him suffer. ...

change to:

JEHAN

... made to suffer as she had made him suffer. ...
